As a Community Volunteer for Stand-by-me Bereavement Support Service for Children, you will play a vital role in representing the charity. Your primary responsibility is to raise both awareness and funds to enable Stand-by-me to continue to provide bereavement support for children, young people and their families.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Raise awareness of the service Stand-by-me offers to bereavement children, young people and their families.
2. Assist with Stand-by-me fundraising events and collaborate with the fundraising lead to identify new opportunities and ideas.
3. Attend and speak about Stand-by-me at community groups, businesses, or organisations interested in fundraising or raising awareness.
4. Participate in volunteer team meetings to stay informed and engaged with Stand-by-me's aims and ethical values.
5. Complete mandatory training as required.
6. Maintain a professional, courteous, and confidential relationship with children, young people, and their families as a representative of Stand-by-me.
7. Support a minimum of three events per year to help Stand-by-me grow and develop for the benefit of bereaved families.

- Willingness to actively participate in events and fundraising efforts.
